**PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** The Executive Committee was thanked for their work (members mentioned by name) and local host Tony Burke thanked for making arrangements at York. Nominations for openings were encouraged. Additionally ongoing response on the report for the purpose/function of CSBS; EDID ad-hoc committee was thanked – executive summary of the EDID report was read; committee recommended fostering culture of transparency, creating program committee to assist prog coordinator, creating task group to further integrate underrepresented scholars/scholarship; task group not yet form, members were encouraged to email interest to Richard Ascough – announcements: 1) papers in French this year, sexuality and gender session, simultaneous translation on the PowerPoints into English; 2) women's scholars lunch at noon tomorrow.

**VP REPORT:** Overseeing of nominations for vacant positions; one vacant position (VP), nominee for this year is Erin Runions; nominations are closed, Erin Runions is the new VP.

**COMMUNICATIONS REPORT:** Three pieces of information. 1) Our prior email server was Mailchimp but numbers have grown beyond its capacity, so the listserve has been moved to Mailerlite; 47% are opening the emails and we would like to increase the effectiveness of this form of communication. 2) Matt has continued to work to expand social media activity (FB/Twitter); currently at 545 followers on Twitter; 741 followers on FB; contact Matt for news related to the society and profession. 3) At last year's AGM, suggestion made to make

## 2. Notes

There are currently 162 paid-up members, of whom 153 paid their membership fees since September 1, 2022 (i.e., in the current fiscal year). This is a fairly significant increase compared to last year: at this time last year, there were 143 paid-up members. The difference is in the number of new members. There have been 41 new members this year, compared with 22 last year.

The numbers this year are encouraging as we have more members than we have had any year since 2018, when CSBS had 192 active members (170 renewals and 22 new members).



## ADDENDUM 2

CSBS Financial Report, May 27, 2023

### **1. Finances: General and Restricted Funds**

The General Fund covers all of the Society's annual operating costs, while the Restricted Funds cover specifically designated expenses, such as book awards and student prizes. The Society pays for all of its annual operating costs and Restricted Funds expenses from an account with Royal Bank, which, as of May 26<sup>th</sup>, has a balance of \$33576,56. An approximate explanation of the society's 2022-2023 General Funds and Restricted Funds thus far is laid out in the two charts below: Statement of Income (Fig. 1); and Statement of Expenses (Fig. 2). Our fiscal year runs from September 1 to August 31.

As the charts make clear, at the moment we have an excess of revenue over expenses in the General Fund of about \$2000; however, there are a number of expenditures that are yet to be made; mainly relating to executive travel. I anticipate that we will end up with approximately equal revenue and expenses; the final financial report will be available in the 2023 bulletin. Our financial position this year is strong due to a few factors: because several members of the executive live in or near Toronto, executive travel expenditures are low; the presence of Congress in Toronto has attracted more members to pay their dues and register for the conference; and we are continuing with having a reception rather than a banquet.

In recent years, it has been the practice to transfer about \$2500-\$3000 from the Endowment Fund to the bank account to help cover the deficit in the operating budget. This year, like last year, we have deemed this transfer to be unnecessary.

**3. Endowment Report (from Bob Derrenbacker)**

**Endowment Committee Members:** Robert Derrenbacker (Chair), Richard Ascough, Mark Leuchter (CSBS Executive Secretary), Michele Murray, Laura Hare (CSBS Treasurer), Wayne McCready (Past Chair, non-voting)

The endowment for the Canadian Society of Biblical Studies (CSBS) is divided into two different funds: The **Inaugural Endowment Fund** (established in 1998) and the **Falconer Endowment Fund** (established in 2018). The total current market value for both endowment funds is \$317,943 (as of 15 May 2023). Both the Inaugural Endowment funds and the Falconer Endowment funds have been invested through Research Capital Corporation (formerly Mackie Research Capital Corporation), but have recently been moved to Acumen Capital to follow our financial advisor, Frank Walker.

The Endowment Committee reports on the Endowment Portfolio to the CSBS Executive twice annually (January/February and May).

The **Inaugural Endowment** has two primary objectives:

- 1. to assist in providing a sustainable financial base for Society initiatives through an endowment
- 2. to make funds available on an annual basis – through earned income from investments – for Society expenses (determined by the Treasurer and the CSBS Executive)

The Inaugural Endowment reflects a 30-year rolling plan investment strategy. Specifically, the portfolio has the following primary categories of investment (current market values provided for 15 May 2023, with a total value of \$244,862):

- 1. Fixed Income (including cash/cash equivalents): \$63,131 (26%)
- 2. Mutual Funds: \$28,269 (11%)
- 3. Common Stock Equities: \$154,188 (63%)

From 1998 to 15 May 2023 the market value of the portfolio increased by approximately 300% from the original investment of \$56,425 for an annual growth of approximately 13% over 23 years. In addition, approximately \$97,000 has been earned during that period through investment income to meet Society expenses or to be re-invested.

Importantly, the Society’s modified dividend growth investment strategy means that annual dividend income from the common stock equities portion of the portfolio is projected to be \$7,824 for 2022.

The **Falconer Endowment Fund** (established 2018) was created to provide support for a short-term research project (\$1,500/year). As of 15 May 2023, the market value of this endowment was \$72,355 as indicated below, with a projected income of \$2,809.

1. Fixed Income (including money market fund/cash):	\$3,396 (4.5%)
2. Common Stock Equities:	\$64,737 (89.5%)
3. Alternative Equities (Auto-Callable Notes):	\$4,222 (6%)
